Hi Ruhann,

I'm not aware of a way to adjust the completion progress on the dashboard, unfortunately. It just picks up all the activities in the course.

What you could do is add 2 Completion Progress blocks to the block drawer in the course, and title one something like "Instructors Completion Progress" and the other "AAs Completion Progress." You would then need to add the relevant activities to each block and this would provide each a group a visual of their completion progress within the course. Note that you have to set the activity completion requirements for each individual activity in order for them to be recognized properly, so it might be a bit of a process to set up. 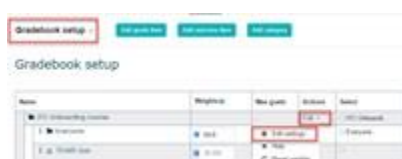

Gotcha! If you were to leave the gradebook as is and continue to exclude empty grades then you would need to enter O's for empty assignments to get an accurate course total. That's probably not ideal.

To **include** empty grades in the calculation, go to the Gradebook Setup screen, select "Edit" on the top row of the table, and then "Edit settings."



Next, under the Grade Category heading, select "show more" and then uncheck the "Exclude empty grades" box. Save your changes.

Now that empty grades you are being *included*, you'll need to try and exclude users from either the Instructors category or the AAs category. To do this, go to the Grader Report screen. Scroll over to the Instructor's total column and click the little pencil icon next to it.



This will bring you to the Single View screen for the category total. Turn on edit mode, and then you'll be able to exclude certain users ( the AAs in this case) from this category total. You'll unfortunately need to do it by individual user rather than by the group.

Then do the same for the AAs category total by excluding Instructors.

This should work, but if something seems off feel free to reach out again.

Hi Brad,

Thanks for your message. The thing is we need it include the empty ones so we can see from the employee's scores if they still haven't completed a section.

At the moment, if a person completed 5 out of 10 activities, and scored 100% on all 5, they are still getting 100% avg grade. But I want it to show only 50% until they have completed all the activities.

Getting an 90%+ grade is mandatory before working in any program.

If this is too complicated, we'll just have to slug through with opening up all the grades and individually checking who hasn't completed what.
